

MARIPOSA WEATHER DATA FOR 2003-2004

BACKYARD HORTICULTURE

The official rain data year is July 1 to June 30. For this past 2003-2004 season, Mariposa (2,000 ft. elevation) received 22.01 inches. Our normal rainfall is 30.18 inches, so we finished the year at 73% of normal. The first winter frost at the Fairgrounds was November 22, about one week earlier than the average December 3 date. Our last spring frost was February 28, more than one month earlier than the normal April 10.
