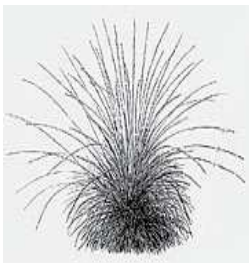




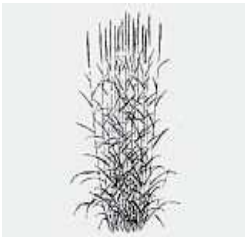
MARIPOSA MASTER GARDENERS PROGRAM

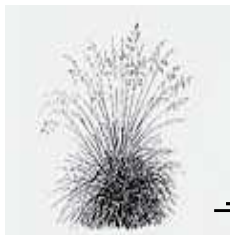
Master Gardeners, Betty Massey & Julie Dowsing will be joined by Jeff Nicholas, at Jeff’s ornamental grass garden for this informative class.
